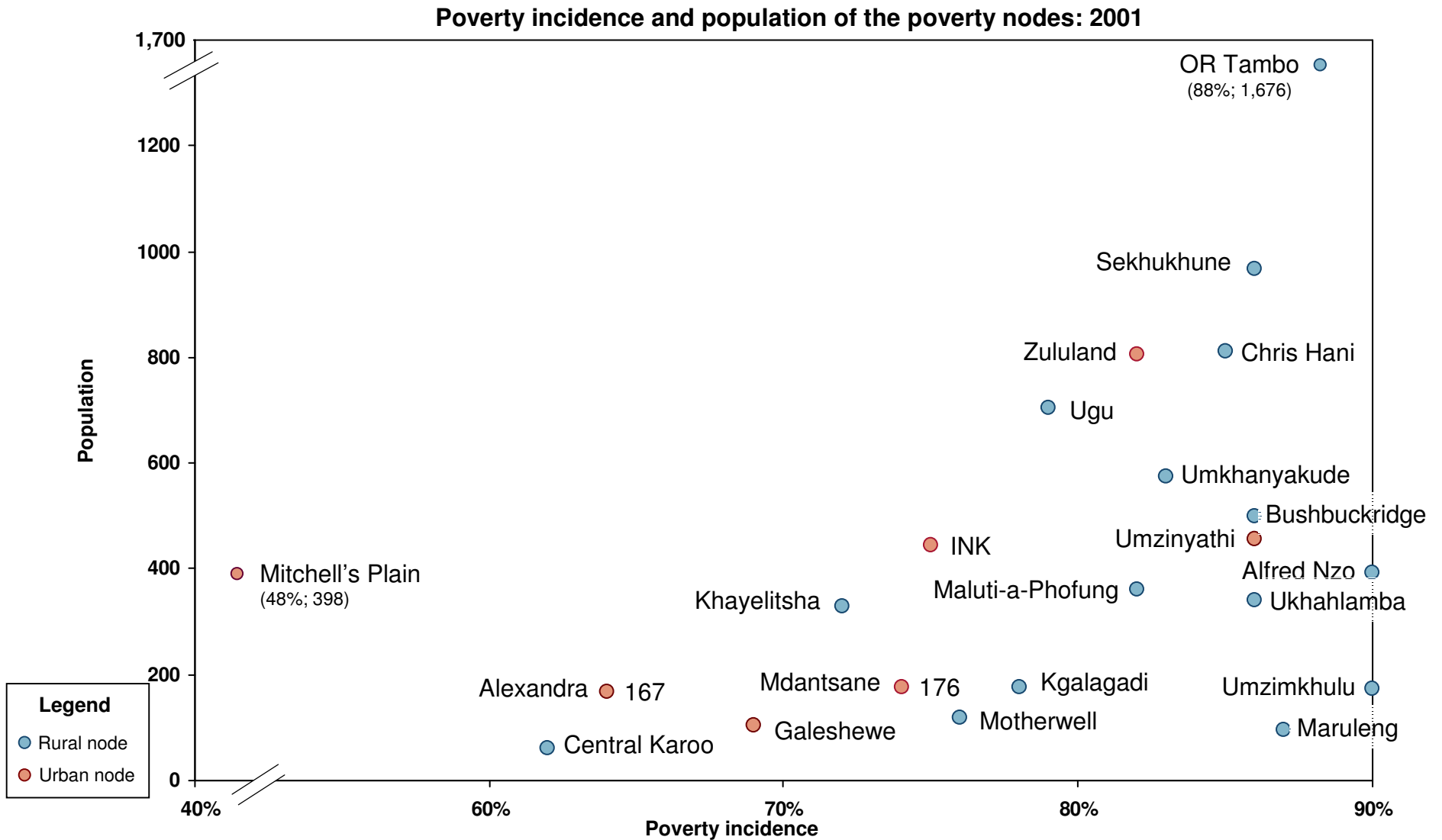

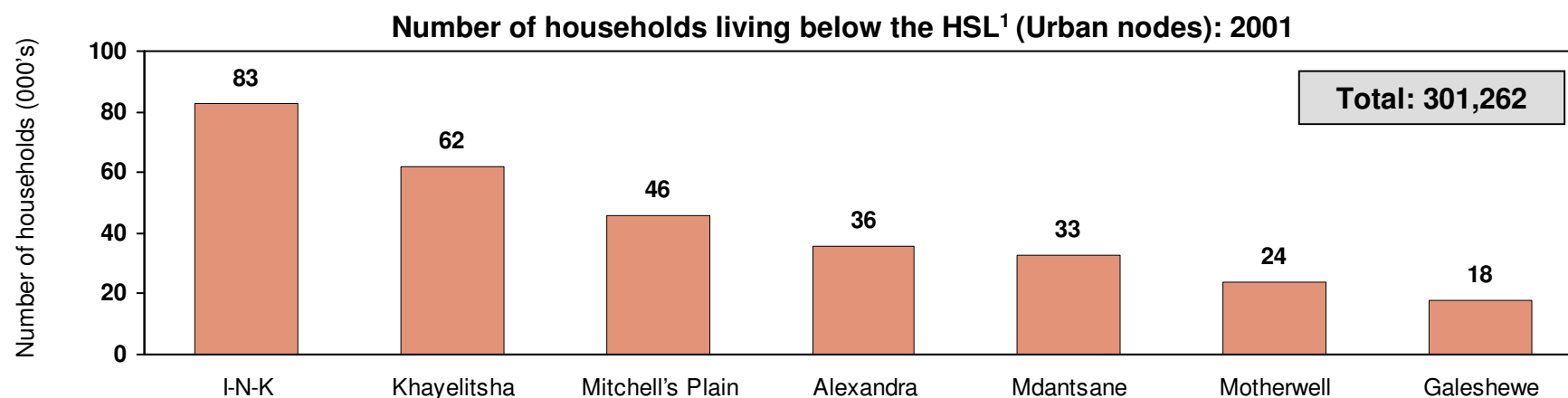
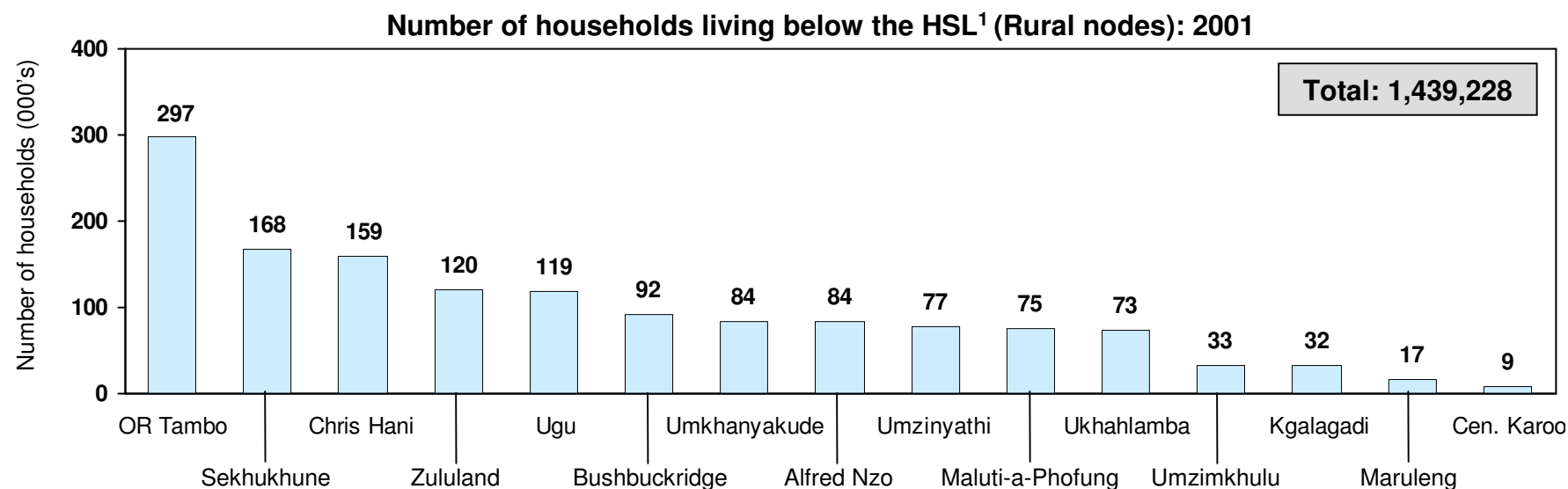

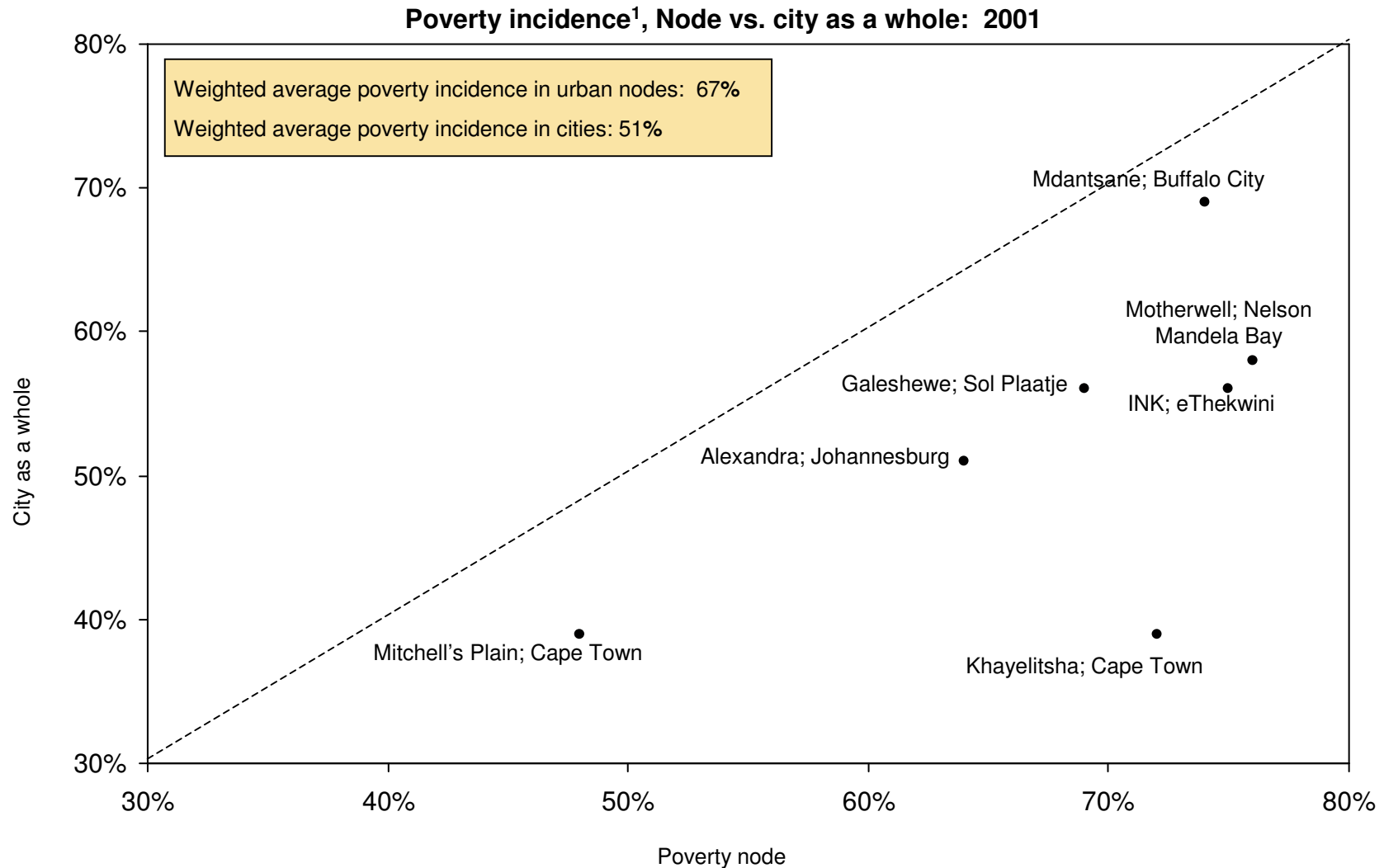
Number of households living below the Household Subsistence Level (HSL)

Poverty incidence in the nodes and in the cities

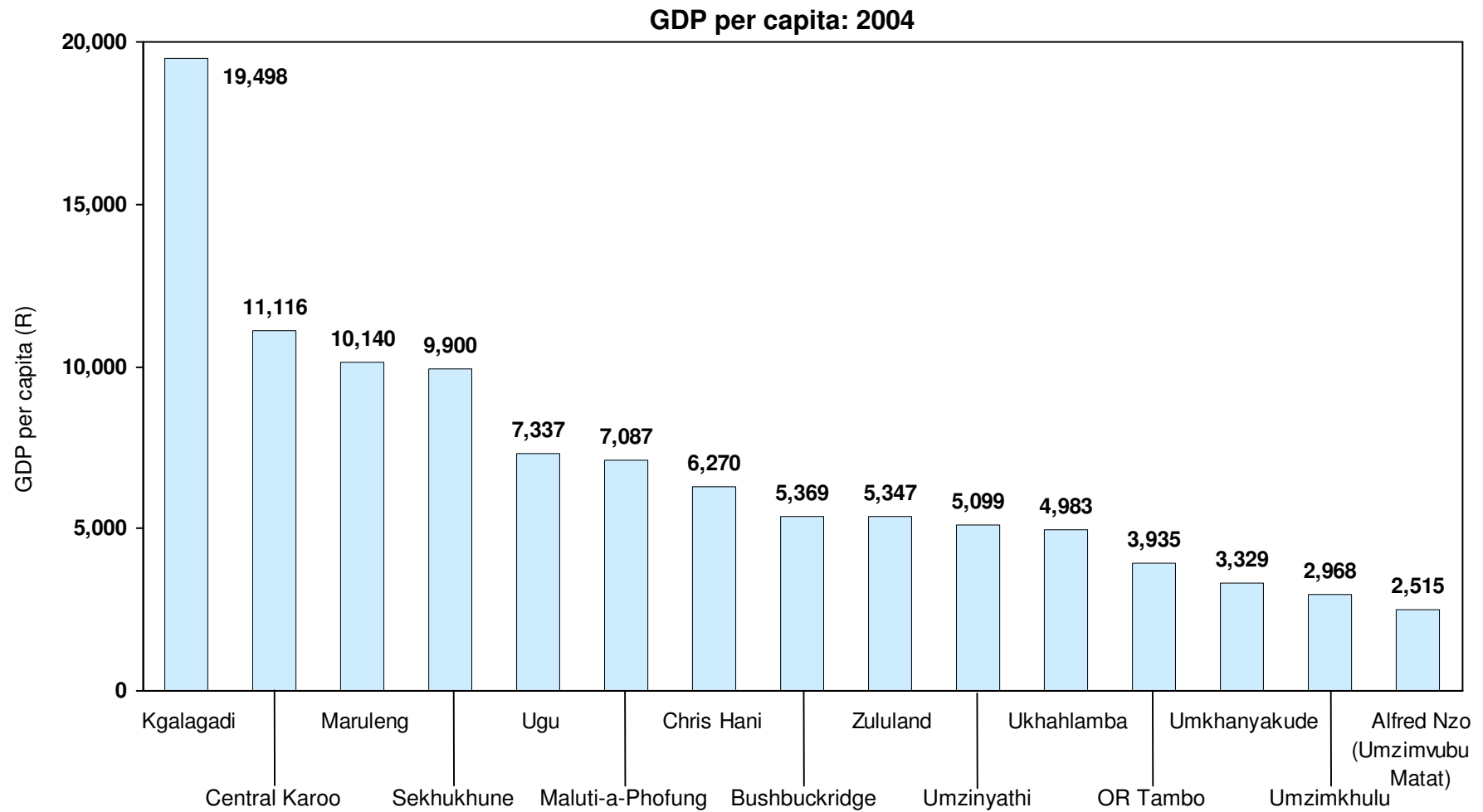
In all cases poverty incidence in the nodes is higher than poverty incidence in the cities

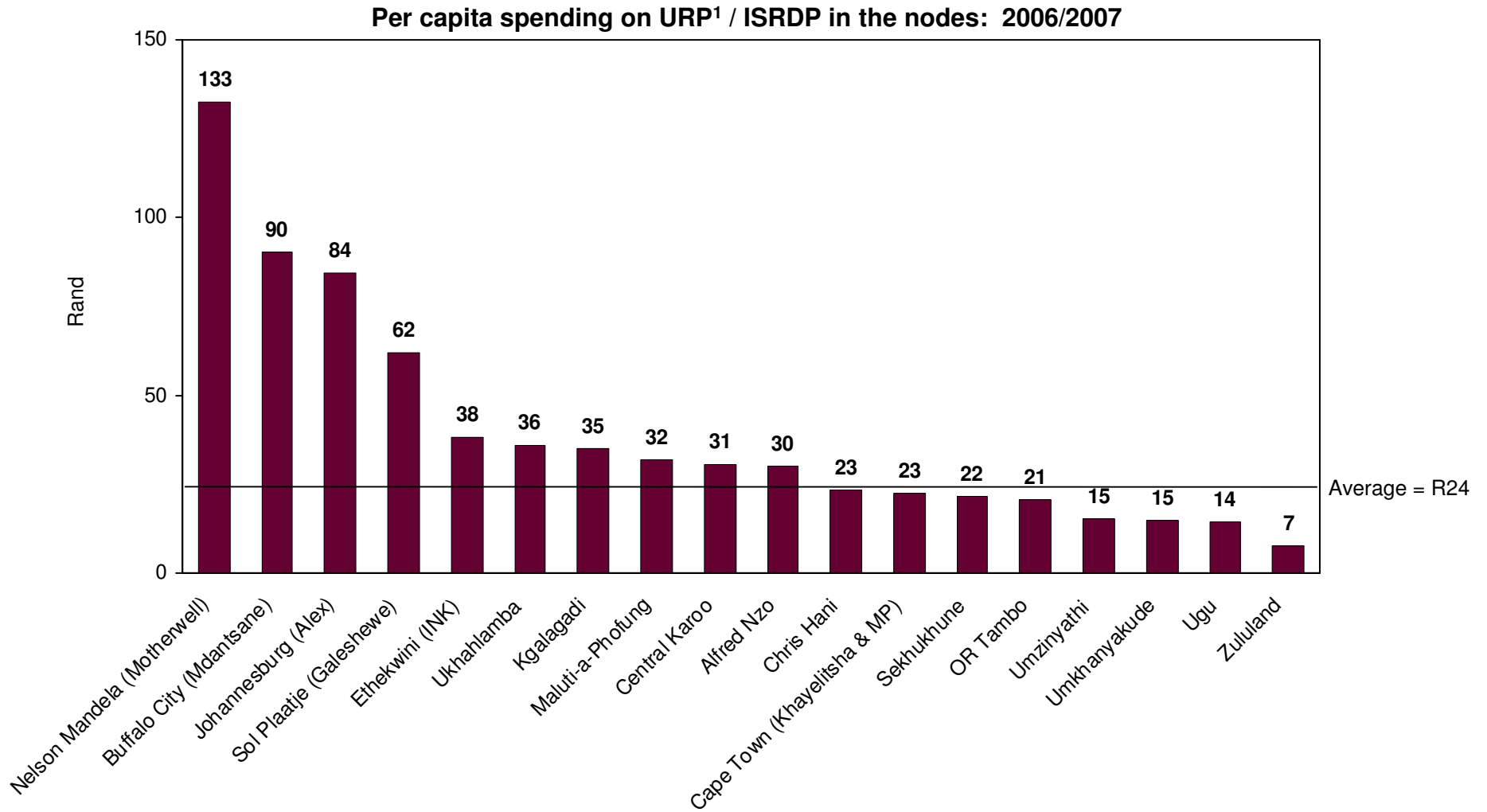
GDP per capita
